Chronic paralysis

Etiological agent

CBPV (Chronic Bee Paralysis Virus) is classified as a positive-sense, single-stranded RNA virus but has not been assigned to a genus or family.

Symptomatic criteria (suspicion):

- Trembling and/or, crawling honeybees(incapacity to fly)at the hive entrance and around the colonies in the apiaries
- Black shiny honeybees, appearing small shiny and hairless
- Honeybees rejected by guards
- Dead honeybees in front of the hive
- Entrance of the hive occupied by sick bees / flying board occupied
- Diarrhea
